Standards Quality Director

Job Description:

The IVSC is searching for a highly effective Standards Quality Director, with a proven track record of leading the development of standards (or comparable experience) and communicating effectively with a diverse range of stakeholders to achieve buy-in to these standards. The Trustees of the IVSC have launched a new approach aimed at establishing the IVSC as the pre-eminent global standard-setter for real property, business, and potentially financial instrument valuations. The Standards Quality Director will be a technical expert responsible for executing the proposed reforms in relation to establishing high-quality standards through more focused Standards Boards.

To succeed, the Standards Quality Director will need to:

- Provide leadership in determining where international valuation standards can be improved and then taking the steps to improve them in an open, transparent and consultative way
- Work effectively with the Chairs and Board members of the Standards Review Board, Tangible Assets Board, Business Valuation Board and Financial Instruments Board to be convened in the future
- Lead a team of highly capable secondee experts
- Work with the CEO to create strong partnerships and collaborative relationships with national and international standard-setters, valuation organisations and other key stakeholders
- Represent the IVSC publicly on issues relating to technical standards
- Help IVSC and the Valuation Professional Organisations achieve recognition and adoption of International Valuation Standards around the world.

Job Qualifications

Qualified candidates should have:

- Senior experience working with or for an international standard-setter, company, or institution
- A qualification in valuation and/or a history of participation/working with the valuation profession
- A general understanding of valuation across all asset types
- Effective diplomatic and communication skills to build relationships on an international basis and establish a robust collaborative approach to standard setting
- A commitment to public accountability, and thus be able to establish the IVSC as a leader in terms of transparency and stakeholder responsiveness
- Effective writing skills

While the IVSC is located in London, the Standards Quality Director would not necessarily need to relocate to London. However, she/he would need to articulate how she/he would work effectively to manage resources and achieve success in developing quality International Valuation Standards and for the IVSC.

Remuneration
